



# **Winnipeg Ringette League Scholarship**

**Purpose:** To annually provide a minimum of two scholarships of \$500.00 each towards post-secondary education for qualified Winnipeg Ringette League players who have demonstrated an academic performance and a strong commitment to the sport of Ringette, leadership and volunteerism.

The number of scholarships to be offered each year will be **a minimum of two** distributed as determined by the Winnipeg Ringette League Scholarship Committee.

## **Eligibility:**

- Must have been a registered player, or involved to some capacity within the Winnipeg Ringette League (past season - player, coach, or manager)
- Must have been a registered player or involved to some capacity within the Winnipeg Ringette League for five out of the last six seasons (player, coach or manager) <u>Pandemic 2020-2021 does not count.</u>
- Must be enrolled and accepted to a full time post-secondary education institution
- Must have maintained a minimum 65% average in the prior school year

#### **Selection Process:**

- Applications will be reviewed by the Winnipeg Ringette League Scholarship Committee, as appointed by the WRL President
- Scholarships will be awarded to the applicants who attain the highest number of points determined in the process established by the scholarship committee
- Ties will be determined by random chance as done by the WRL President
- Decision by the Scholarship Committee will be final and not subject to any appeal

## **Application Procedure:**

Applications for 2022 scholarships will be accepted until <u>5pm on June 20th, 2025</u>. Any applications received after 5pm on June 20th, 2025 will not be accepted.

### **Administration of Scholarships:**

- Applicant must provide evidence of acceptance for full-time enrollment at a post-secondary institution for the upcoming academic year
- Applicant must provide a copy of receipt for payment for full-time enrollment at a post-secondary institution for the upcoming academic year prior to award disbursement
- Successful applicants must agree to posting of their name and photograph on the WRL website and other media outlets

Required Items	Points (Maximum)
<b>Cover letter</b> (a detailed ringette resume covering all aspects of the applicant's sport activity as a player, coach, official, instructor, and/or volunteer)	15 points (amount awarded to be determined by the selection committee)
A <b>letter of impact</b> documenting the significance of participation in the Winnipeg Ringette League as a participant in the applicant's personal development; what is your future within the sport	20 points (amount awarded to be determined by the selection committee)
<b>TWO letters of reference</b> bearing a current date from non-family members of the Winnipeg Ringette League community (i.e. coach, club convenor, association president, etc.,)	10 points (amount awarded to be determined by the selection committee)
<b>Documented</b> six years in the WRL (U12 through to U19)	5 points (amount awarded to be determined by the selection committee)
<b>Volunteer time (outside of Ringette)</b> – Documentation specifying what types of volunteer-related activities the participant has engaged in <b>OUTSIDE</b> of the sport	15 points (amount awarded to be determined by the selection committee)
Work within Ringette (paid) – Indicate any paid activities within the sport of Ringette (i.e. referee, timekeeper, scorekeeper, shot clock operator)	10 points (amount awarded to be determined by the selection committee)
Volunteer time/work within Ringette (NOT paid) – Documentation specifying what types of volunteer-related activities the participant has engaged within the sport of Ringette	20 points (amount awarded to be determined by the selection committee)
Scholastic average 80% or higher	5 points (amount awarded to be determined by the selection committee)
A transcript of marks for the last completed year of education	MANDATORY
